Background:

Kingston Carers' Network (KCN) is a charity that supports carers in the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames. A carer provides unpaid support to a friend or family member who has a physical illness, disability, mental health or substance misuse issue.

How you can help:

We are looking for a reliable, computer-literate volunteer to spend a couple of hours a week actively promoting Kingston Carers' Network on our social media platforms. This can be done from our office or from home. Our office is based at: 418 Ewell Road, Tolworth, KT6 7HF

Your role:

As a social media volunteer, you will assist the communications officer with maintaining and developing KCN's online presence, this may include:

- Designing elements for use on social media (using Canva or similar software)
- Uploading and scheduling posts on our social media pages (Facebook, Twitter, Instagram)
- Uploading content to the KCN website
- Compiling ebulletins

We ask that you would:

- Make a regular commitment of at least 2 hours per week, for a minimum of 6 months
- Communicate any training needs to the Communications Officer/Volunteer
 Manager
