Who we are and what we do

Kingston Carers' Network is a local charity, providing independent advice, advocacy and support to people who care for someone living in the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames. We support carers of all ages, helping over 3,000 carers in 2017 including over 500 young carers aged 5 to 18.

KCN is funded from a combination of contracts with local commissioners, grant funding and a small amount of donations.

Strategic Review

Under strong leadership KCN has expanded from a small charity to one managing a revenue budget of over £700,000 with a six-fold increase in the number of carers we support. The Board has recently completed a strategic review, and is embarking on a strengthening of the Board and a review of KCN's management structure.
