Kingston Carers' Network is a local charity, providing independent advice, advocacy and support to people who care for someone living in the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames. We support carers of all ages, helping over 4,000 carers in 2020 including nearly 800 young carers aged 5 to 18.

KCN is funded from a combination of contracts with local commissioners, grant funding and a small amount of donations.
